



## **TUNG WAH GROUP OF HOSPITALS 144<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY SCHOLARSHIP**

### **REGULATIONS**

#### **Name**

Tung Wah Group of Hospitals 144<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Scholarship (hereafter referred to as Scholarship).

#### **Aim**

To award outstanding students of local secondary schools, upon Principals' nomination, who pursue Year 1 undergraduate programme in a local higher education institution.

#### **Number of Awards**

A maximum of ten scholarships will be awarded to students to subsidize their tuition fees, learning activities and living expenses.

#### **Amount**

The recipients of the Scholarship shall each receive a lump sum of \$20,000. Meanwhile, they may continue to receive other scholarships at the same time and the scholarship will not decrease under such circumstances.

#### **Criteria**

Each local secondary school Principal may nominate 1 student of the school who attained level 5\*\* in 2 or more subjects<sup>#</sup> in the 2014 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination and were admitted to a full-time registered undergraduate programme for the 2014-2015 academic year in a local higher education institution. Selected students should have outstanding academic performance, good character, devotion to community affairs, and active participation in extra-curricular activities and voluntary work. Priority will be given to students from families receiving the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance or receiving full-grant under the Student Financial Assistance Scheme, and to those who have experience of overcoming adversity.

# Mathematics Compulsory Part and Mathematics Extended Part are counted as one subject, and attaining level 5\*\* in either part is acceptable for the requirement of having attained level 5\*\* in the subject. However, attaining level 5\*\* in both the Mathematics Compulsory Part and Mathematics Extended Part can only be counted as one subject.

### **Procedures**

Principals of secondary schools concerned will be invited for nomination in October. Shortlisted students will be invited for interview in November / December. Students who are not notified by the end of December may consider their applications unsuccessful.

### **Announcement**

Results will be announced in February / March and schools making nominations will be notified.
